The program served 40 interns for the period of September 1, 2017 through October 31, 2018. Participants were high school students, college and non-college students from O‘ahu, Maui, Moloka‘i , Lana‘i and Hawai‘i Island. Training and certifications were integrated in our projects and are in line with KIRC’s Mission. The program focuses on three principles: ‘ike, hana ka ‘ike and hana me ke aloha.

Aside from accesses to Kaho‘olawe, week long training camps were held in the summer. This allowed interns from the other islands to participate in Maui based projects, training, and workshops in an environment that fostered team building, leadership as well as peer mentoring.
