Activities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 56 paddlers and boat crew will depart from Makena Landing at 5:30am and enter the Reserve off of Lae Halona between 5:45am and 6:00am and paddle and sail clockwise around the island on 4 escort boats (Pualele, Nahenahe, Isla Kai and); 2 six man canoes and 4 two man canoes. At approximately 10:00am to 10:30am the canoes and escort boats will arrive at Honokanai‘a for a layover. The group will conduct the landing cultural protocol; canoes will land on the beach and paddlers will rest while the escort boats will float off shore; paddlers will cool off (by swimming), eat snacks, hydrate and then continue on their ka‘apuni, leaving after 30 to 45 minutes. Escort boats will not anchor and do not need to moor, as they will just float nearshore. The canoes and escort boats will continue the ka‘apuni and are estimated to depart the reserve between 12:00 and 1:00pm, arriving at Makena at approximately 2:00pm.
